

Maternal lodine Supplementation: Clinical Trials and Assessment of Outcomes September 22–23, 2014

Rodrigo Moreno-Reyes, M.D., Ph.D., is the head of the clinic in the Department of Nuclear Medicine at Erasme Hospital and a lecturer on endocrine physiology at the Université Libre de Bruxelles (ULB). Previously he worked for Doctors Without Borders in Darfur, Sudan, documenting the severe iodine deficiency in this region. His scientific interests include iodine nutrition and thyroid diseases including thyroid cancer, thyroid imaging by ultrasound, thyroid scintigraphy, and positron emission tomography (PET) scanning. He has conducted several epidemiological studies on iodine nutrition in Belgium and abroad, including Sudan and Tibet. He represents Belgium in the Iodine Global Network and advises the Belgian Ministry of Health on iodine nutrition policy. Dr. Moreno-Reyes qualified from medical school from the ULB and trained in tropical medicine at the Institute of Tropical Medicine of Antwerpen, Belgium. He received a diploma in statistics and epidemiology from the School of Public Health of the ULB, performed a 5-year fellowship in internal medicine and endocrinology at Erasme Hospital of ULB, and received his Ph.D. related to selenium and iodine deficiency.
